Linda Bond, Purchasing a Marquee for Thornbury Hamlets.	A resident had been contacted who has one for sale, this was discussed together with how to fund the purchase. It was resolved the clerk would contact T.P. Plan members and call a meeting to revisit this Plan. On the agenda would be the T.P.P. account and how to progress further to possibly obtain funding for a Community Marquee.

3.Annual Fun day.	A very successful evening was reported, total figure realised £1018.40.	Clerk had thanked by email all committee members and everyone else who had given their time.
2018-19 Communities Together Fund [previously TAP]	M. Galley-Taylor's proposal regarding a possible purchase of a marquee for community use. It was agreed to include this in the Tatler and on the Website for residents to either come back with comments on this proposal or any other suggestions they might have for the £261.00 allocated from C.M.T. for Thornbury Hamlets, this would be included in the November meeting's agenda.	
5.Road Wardens report.	K.H. read email from P.T. regarding the new Neighbourhood Highways Engineer post for Vicky Braddon. P. Taylor updated councillors on the progress made regarding pot holes filled, further holes had been logged, and appreciation was stated for Highways for the excellent work now completed at Lashbrook. An ongoing issue regarding flooding at Brendon side lane would be raised with Highways. A condition of the CDT grant was the more detailed creation of Thornbury's Emergency Plan, this has been done and agreed by T.P.C. and published on the website, an A4 leaflet was distributed with the May edition of the 'Tatler' giving advice on being prepared for emergencies and useful contact numbers. Cheque for £530.01 was signed for P.T. regarding his recent purchase of a 'Wacker Plate' and tools.	Clerk to add this to T.P.C.'s Asset Register.
6.Nth Devon Archive Service Forward Plan 2018-19	Councillors had been forwarded these proposals; it was discussed whether Thornbury could contribute to funding for a seven month short term agreement from April 2019 and an annual contribution towards the five year agreement running from the expiry of the short term agreement, it was proposed by T.J. and seconded by C.W. that at this present time no funding could be contributed to this plan, but members agreed that this service for North Devon is appreciated and hopefully will continue.	
7.Correspondence for discussion.	Licensing Policy Consultation was discussed, and no further comments were made. Merger of Devon and Cornwall Police with Dorset was discussed, and no further comments were made. Data Protection Bill; councillors had been forwarded two emails on the update for Local Councils, in April and July from Jamie Hollis these would be kept on record.
