

Thornbury Parish Council

Planning Policy

Thornbury Parish Council meets four times annually, which does not align with the response deadlines attached to consultation requests from Torrington District Council, which are typically four weeks. The Plans Committee for Thornbury Parish Council consists of all of the members of Council.

Thornbury Parish Council has therefore resolved that it can decide its response to a planning application consultation in one of two ways:

1. Consideration in public at a properly constituted meeting of the full Parish Council, if this is possible within the response timetable described above.
2. The Parish Council has delegated authority to the Proper Officer (Clerk) to respond to non-contentious planning applications following consultation with the members of the Council. This does not require a public meeting. No agenda or minutes are necessary, but a report of planning comments made will be presented to the next full meeting of the Parish Council.
